CitizenHeritage (2020-2023) is a Strategic Partnership project funded by the European Commission in the frame of the Erasmus+ Programme. CitizenHeritage aims to provide Higher Education Institutions with novel approaches to include citizen science activities with cultural heritage into their curricula and teaching&learning activities.

After a number of Citizen Science workshops that took place in 2021 and the first outreach event of the project "[The role of photographic heritage in empowering communities participation in cultural heritage](#)" held in Pisa on 28th June 2022, the project continues with various actions:

- a published **report** from the survey and desktop research carried on during the project, about the various existing practices in citizen engagement and participation in cultural heritage;
- more **citizen engagement events**, among which a workshop organized by Photoconsortium in the context of EUROMED conference in Cyprus on the 8th November 2022 and a students challenge organized by the National Technical University of Athens;
- **dissemination and knowledge sharing** in relevant events and conferences about higher education and open science.
